Dear Ellison Park Parents and Community,

Welcome Back! I trust you are enjoying the summer break and hope your family is staying safe and healthy.

As you are all aware, we are in the middle of a global pandemic and the numbers in our state are increasing. The announcement this week to minimize the number of people in the building was a direct result of the health crisis. Your teacher will also be sending a video showing the classroom set-up and needed items to help make the start of school successful. ## August 7: Access Encore and your new teacher for 2020-2021

Access MyDSD to read and sign all forms necessary to start the school year. Just a friendly reminder to sign up for Smiths Rewards and Amazon Smiles to help our school.

# August 19 and 20th: Solo Selfie at School

This would be a good time to take your picture in front of the school since you will not have that opportunity on the first day of school. There will be balloons and a banner to stand in front of. On the first day of school we will be vigilant about physical distancing as a part of our drop-off procedure.

### **August 20: Teacher Virtual Presentations**

These presentations will be sent out from your student's teacher. Check your email.

### August 24-28: Kindergarten Kick-off

Kindergarten testing will take place on the first week of school so there will be no class-time until Monday, August 31. If you have a kindergartener, please call the school during office hours on Wednesdays, or go to myDSD, to schedule a 10-minute appointment to meet your teacher and see the classroom. In addition, you will need to schedule a time on myDSD for your child to come to the school and complete the KEEP TEST.

**August 24:** Back to School Morning Open House 9:30-11:45 **Staggered Times:** A-H @9:30, I-P @10:15, Q-Z @11:00

This year Back to School Morning will have a virtual video component as well as an opportunity for families to come to the classroom to meet the teacher. We ask that you come in through the front doors, wear your mask, sign in at the tables, only come with your Ellison Park students, physically distance, come during your time and do not linger in the building.

August 25: First Day of School! (B-Day students — last name begins with L-Z) DROP OFF TIMES ARE BY LAST NAME: L-O @8:30, P-S @8:40, T-Z @8:50

August 26: First Day of School! (A-Day students — last name begins with A-K) DROP OFF TIMES ARE BY LAST NAME: A-C @8:30, D-G @8:40, H-K @8:50

All students will enter through the front doors on their opening day only.

On the first day of school, we are celebrating your child as they come in through the front doors. Red carpet, banners, balloons, and music. Staff Members will be there helping to guide students to their classrooms. In an effort to follow the Big 5 and keep our students safe and healthy, we ask that parents do not enter the building. We will be serving lunch every day. Remote day lunches will be grab and go at the main door.
