Minutes read from last meeting

School Improvement Plan Goals

Goal 1: Increase K-6 "typical or higher progress" on EOY benchmark to 75%. Goal 2: Increase Math proficiency by 2% as measured by End of Level Testing. Goal 3: Increase Science proficiency by 2% as measured by End of Level Testing. Goal 4: Incorporate SEL for all students and staff to develop self-awareness and self-management skills and achieve academic and social/emotional success in math and reading as measured by SEL Walkthrough Tool and DSD Climate Survey.

K-3 Acadience Math data (grade level specific) passed around David would like to purchase a digital math testing program, Acadience or otherwise, for grades 4-6 next year. Look at data MOY-MOY. Parent idea to send home a letter to parents showing where their student is at compared to entire grade level; thinks would be eye opening to parents; several committee members agreed.

Goal 1: We are at 71%, 4% to go. David proposes math and reading data MOY-MOY for next year

STEAM lab. About \$27,000 to purchase supplies for Makerspace (audio visual equipment, 18 circuit boards, 18 dot and dash robots/cards, 2 sets of Ozobots, 4 3D printers, set of iPads and computers for classroom)

Won't do after school program until CMI and LETRS are done. If any parents are interested, they can volunteer to do a school play or choir.

Staffing staying the same this year to next year.

Condo development going in, plus The Park and Mary Meadows will bring enrollment up.

Changing computer prep to STEAM prep, will teach basic Office skills as well. Goal 3: Science goal - change to use STEAM lab for everyone, K-6, to create/build, per don't want to use RISE scores

Goal 4: SEL goal - will keep that the same. David will look into The Great Handshake. Nikki and David talked about having houses throughout the school in the next couple of years. Parent brought up kidsthatgogood.com. Nikki will look into. (maybe just for student council)

David will write up goals to propose at the next meeting and can tweak, if needed.

Need for substitutes was brought up.
