Welcome – Pledge of Allegiance

Minutes read from last meeting

School Improvement Plan Goals

Goal 1: Increase K-6 “typical or higher progress” on EOY benchmark to 75%.

Goal 2: Increase Math proficiency by 2% as measured by End of Level Testing.

Goal 3: Increase Science proficiency by 2% as measured by End of Level Testing.

Goal 4: Incorporate SEL for all students and staff to develop self-awareness and self-management skills and achieve academic and social/emotional success in math and reading as measured by SEL Walkthrough Tool and DSD Climate Survey.

Goal 1 MOY Update: We had 112 red students at the BOY and now have 90 red students. Yellows stayed consistent. Enrollment went up from 550 (BOY) -589 (MOY.) We are 4% away from the 71% goal. We had 3% growth 68% (BOY) to 71% (MOY.)

Goal 2 and goal 3 Update: no data for math and science

David talked about switching math goal to compare MOY-MOY to give a true comparison with Acadience instead of going off end of level tests.

Goal 4 Update: in process of walkthrough tool and climate survey
